## **Sunil K Pandya**

Dr. Sunil Pandya was appointed Professor of Neurosurgery at Seth G S Medical College and K E M Hospital, Mumbai in 1975 and retired on superannuation in 1998. An alumnus of Grant Medical College and Sir J. J. Group of Hospitals, Mumbai, he obtained his M.B. & B.S. from University of Bombay in 1961 and MS (General Surgery) in 1965. His training in neurosurgery was under the guidance and supervision of Dr. GajendraSinh (at J. J. Hospital) and Dr. HomiDastur (at K. E. M. Hospital). Later he pursued further specialty training in the Institute of Neurology, London, with Professor Valentine Logue.

He has written essays - in scientific journals as well as popular press - on neurosurgery, the history of medicine and issues pertinent to ethics in medicine. He is the Emeritus Editor of the *Indian Journal of Medical Ethics* and serves on the editorial boards of medical journals such as the *National Medical Journal of India* and *Mens Sana Monographs*.

Dr Pandya is a life member of the Neurological Society of India and the Asiatic Society of Bombay.
